A Licence has been granted for this competition and accreditation will be applied for through SASA North District. Poolside/changing room access will be limited to team coaches and chaperones up to a maximum of one coach/chaperone per 10 swimmers, with a maximum of 3 coaches/chaperones at any one time. Clubs are responsible for clearing their seating area of belongings, litter, etc. before leaving at the end of the competition day. Bin liners for plastic bottles/recyclable items and for general waste will be distributed around the pool - please use them. Glass bottles or containers and hot drinks are not permitted in the pool area - this does <u>not</u> include the spectator areas. Coaches should ensure that their swimmers enter and exit the warm ups at the allotted times. Swimmers must not enter the pool until their warm- up start is announced and must follow all instructions.
