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	Closing date for entries is Friday 25 th August 2023 – late entries will not be accepted.
	Entries may have to be limited depending upon the number of entries received. Clubs will be notified of any rejected swims prior to the meet along with a provisional program.
Trophies	Medals will be awarded in age groups for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each event. There will be awards for best boy and girl in each age group. The Cults Otters ASC Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the best club / team. Trophies for best boy / girl in each age group and best club / team will be worked on a points system – 6 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 6th place. Medals and Trophies should be collected from the Medals desk.
Venue Capacity	Due to venue capacity, there may be a requirement to reject swimmers accepted for only 1 or 2 individual races in favour of other swimmers to maximise pool time/capacity.
Photography	No photographic or video equipment will be allowed in any area without prior agreement of the Gala Convener. Application forms will be available from the Gala Convener and must be countersigned by a club official. Photographic permission will not be issued for mobile phones. Unless it has been notified in writing to the Gala Convener it will be assumed that all parents of children swimming give permission for their child to be photographed by approved parties. Photography of any description, and the use of mobile phones or any other devices capable of photography is strictly prohibited in the changing room, showers, and toilets. The use of mobile phones poolside is prohibited
Changing Room	The changing room at the pool will be available for use but time in this area should be limited as far as possible. Bags can be taken into the seating area where space in that area allows. No belongings can be left in the changing rooms.
Marshalling and Instructions	Swimmers must report to marshalling ahead of their event otherwise they will not be permitted to swim. The start of a race will not be delayed for absent competitors. Swimmers must follow instructions given to them by meet officials and marshals, and must behave in a reasonable manner at all times.
Spectating	Due to building restrictions on numbers there is strictly no spectating availability. All available space is being utilised for swimmers and STO's.
Technical Officials	We would be grateful for the offer of technical officials (qualified timekeepers, Judges). Please advise if you can assist in a technical role by completing the STO form



	attached and returning to the Gala Convener with the entry and in any event no later than 3 September 2023.	
	Any queries or changes to Technical Officials after the closing date should also be directed to the Gala Convener. All clubs are expected to provide a minimum of 1 Judge per session. Clubs that have 10 swimmers or more accepted should provide a minimum of 2 technical officials per session, at least one of which should hold a minimum qualification of Judge 1.	
Mentoring requests will be considered by the Referee. It may be more likely mentoring requests to be honoured if the clubs attending the meet provide qualified officials (Judge & above), however we cannot guarantee all reques granted.		
	Please note that Timekeepers or Judges-in-training requiring specific signatures, i.e. Chief timekeeper or stroke, should make this request to the Gala Convener when names are submitted.	
Withdrawals	Must be notified to <u>cultsotters.galaorg@gmail.com</u> before 5pm Friday 15 th September 2023 and after this to the Recorders table on the day – withdrawals should be notified at least 1 hour prior to the start of the appropriate session.	
	Entries & Results	
	In order to operate the Cults Otters Challenge Trophy, we have a legitimate interest to collect and process some basic personal data from all competitors, specifically name, gender, date of birth.	
Data Protection	This data will be held securely and only used for the purposes of managing the meet and reporting results. The data will be retained in accordance with Licence Requirements. Names and ages will be shared with attending clubs and SASA ND and may be published. Name, gender and date of birth will only be used when submitting the results to Scottish Rankings for the purpose of maintaining the National Database.	
	By entering the Cults Otters Challenge Trophy competitors agree to allow Cults Otters ASC to publish the personal data submitted within the entry file and allow publication of results.	
Coaches Pass	One coach's lunch pass will be included for each Club with an additional pass per 10 swimmers entered. Additional coaches' passes will be available at £5.00 each – please include this payment with the gala entry fee.	
Refunds	In the event of postponement, cancellation or abandonment of the event or withdrawals at any time, refunds will be made at the absolute discretion of Cults Otters ASC.
