Eligibility to Enter

This meet is open to swimmers who are members of Clubs affiliated to the North District or the Midland District of the SASA.

Swimmers are eligible to win medals and awards for the District of the club they are representing at the Championships.

All events will be run in two eligibility categories – Male & Open, and Female.

Age is at 31 December 2024. Competitors may swim only in their own age group.

Age groups for individual events are 11 - 13 years, 14/15 years, 16/17 years, and 18 years and over.

Please note that individual events will be swum with age groups combined according to the programme of events.

Team events will be open to teams comprising swimmers aged 11 - 14 and swimmers aged 15 and over. Each event will be run separately OR combined and seeded by time at the discretion of the Referee.

Para Swimming Events

Swimmers from the North and Midland Districts who have a recognised classification (WPS, BS, BBS, UKSA or INAS-FID) and are registered members of Scottish Swimming will be eligible to compete in the multi-classification (MC) events. The MC events will be integrated into the heats of each age group seeded by absolute time. Please refer to the Supplementary Para Swimming Conditions for more information. Please ensure that any MC swimmers are identified as such with their classification at the point of entry.

On application to the relevant Swimming Convenor, which must be prior to the closing date for the round, entries from swimmers with a disability or impairment that do not have a classification or meet the eligibility criteria, may be allowed to compete. The Swimming Convenor's decision is final.

Consideration Times

There are separate consideration times for Female and Male & Open ages 11/12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15 years, 16 years, 17 and over to maximise opportunity.

Consideration times for individual events are attached. Please note that accredited times are required, from meets licensed at level 1 or level 2 (or a foreign equivalent), and a Proof of Times report must be submitted with entry. Accepted entries may have to be limited dependent upon numbers received in which case entries will be accepted across age groups (entry age) as evenly as is practical.

There are no consideration times for team events, but <u>entry times must be submitted</u> and these should be the sum of the times of four swimmers eligible to swim in that event.

Entries

All entries must be on Hy-tek Team Manager entry file (North District Rule SW 4.1).

CLOSING DATE FOR ELECTRONIC ENTRIES IS FRIDAY 12 JANUARY 2024 for Round 1 and FRIDAY 2 FEBRUARY 2024 for Round 2.

Please note payment must be received within 3 postal days of this date and there will be zero tolerance of late payment. Any entry that is not accompanied by payment in the specified timeframe will be rejected without delay.

The fee for entries received which are outwith the consideration times or conditions for this competition shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

Entry fees

Payment is preferred by BACS. Reference should be AGEC followed by the round and your club code eg AGEC1NANX. Bank details for payments are on the summary sheets.

Early Withdrawals

NB: All details must be included on e-mail withdrawals ie Name, Event No, Stroke, Comp No etc. Telephone and WhatsApp withdrawals will not be accepted.

Withdrawals at the Meet

Withdrawals from heats at the meet should be notified on the withdrawal form issued.

The sheets should be handed in to the recorders' table at least 1 hour prior to the start of the appropriate session. See North District Rule SW5.1(b).

Qualifying for Finals

There will be heats and finals for all 50m, 100m events and for 200m Individual Medley with the finals age-grouped as 11 - 13 years, 14/15 years and 16/17 years and 18 years and over.

Withdrawals from Finals

Swimmers who wish to withdraw from a final must inform the recorder and complete the withdrawal form no later than 30 minutes after finalists lists have been published or announced. This will ensure that a reserve can be given the opportunity to compete, and the final seeded accordingly. North District Rule SW 5.1 refers. Withdrawals from finals or in the case of illness should be completed on withdrawal forms available from the recorders.

Any competitor withdrawing from a final in such a manner as to prevent a reserve taking part (except in the case of proven illness or emergency) shall be suspended immediately from all further events at the Meet. Where a reserve is brought in at short notice, the reserve shall occupy the vacant lane; there will be no re-seeding.

Marshalling

There will be marshalling for all heats, all finals and for relays.

All swimmers must present themselves to the marshal before their events and are advised to attend in good time.

Swimmers may report to marshalling for more than one event where it is deemed that there will be insufficient time between races to marshal in good time for their next event. It is for the swimmer to inform the marshal if they are reporting for more than one event.

The start of a race will not be delayed for absent competitors and swimmers who have not presented themselves to the marshals prior to their heat entering the final marshalling area will not be permitted to swim, will be treated as a late withdrawal and may be fined accordingly.

Reserves

Reserves must present themselves to the marshal unless they have withdrawn.

Medals and Awards North District

North District

North District Medals will be awarded for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} places achieved by North District swimmers in all events according to age groupings 11-13 years, 14/15 years, 16/17 years and 18 years and over. Medals will not be presented but can be collected from the Medal Desk outside the Timing Room on the pool deck.

Grampian Rosebowl, Sam Muir Quaich, Jean Muir Memorial Trophies and Welsh Trophies will be awarded according to North District rule SW12.3. using World Aquatics points as the scoring method. The Roy Wilson Trophy will be awarded to the Best Club using points scored 10-1 over all events. Points will be scored from Finals and Timed Finals only. Awards will be presented at the end of Round 2.

Medals and Awards Midland District

Midland District Medals will be awarded for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} places achieved by Midland District swimmers in all events according to age groupings 11-13 years, 14/15 years, 16/17 years and 18 years and over. Medals will not be presented but can be collected from the Medal Desk outside the Timing Room on the pool deck.

Midland District Open Trophies will be awarded to the fastest first claim Midland District swimmer of any age in the event. Midland District Junior Trophies will be awarded to the fastest first claim Midland District swimmer aged under 17 years on 31 December 2024 as follows:

Technical Officials

North District Clubs must submit lists of Swimming Technical Officials to the Meet Officials Convenor (Colin Oswald) in accordance with North District Regulations using the Swimming Technical Officials workbook available on North District website here. Please complete one sheet for each session of the meet.

Lists for all sessions for each round must be emailed (not posted) to the Meet Officials Convenor, Colin Oswald at theoswalds2@icloud.com no later than 14 days before the first day of the meet (Friday 26 January 2024 for Round 1 and Friday 16 February 2024 for Round 2). Failing to submit the form in accordance with these conditions will be considered a failure to submit the form. North District rules SW 6.2 and SW4.1 refer.

Midland District Clubs are requested to submit lists of Swimming Technical Officials to the Meet Officials Convenor (Colin Oswald) in accordance with North District Regulations using the Swimming Technical Officials workbook available on North District website here. Please complete one sheet for each session of the meet.

Please note that probationary Judges and Timekeepers wishing specific signatures, eg. chief timekeeper or stroke, should make this request to the Meet Officials Convenor when names are submitted.

Mentoring will be at the discretion of the referees during heats sessions only depending on the availability of suitable mentors.

Photos/ Videos

The use of mobile phones or other devices capable of photography is not permitted at any time in the changing village, toilets or shower areas and they must be switched to silent in the pool hall.

Anyone wishing to use photographic equipment at the Championships, including video cameras must register with the Meet Convenor (application should be made on the appropriate Scottish Swimming Health and Safety form (which may be electronic and signed or endorsed by the relevant club official).

Media/ Photography

Throughout this event SASA North District may have authorised media partners taking static photographs and video footage. These images are intended solely for the purposes of promotion and celebration of the activities and may include live streaming on the internet. Images will be uploaded to our website and our social network sites. Should any competitor wish not to be photographed please complete the Media/Photography Refusal of Consent Form which is available on our website. If at any time a competitor wishes a static image to be removed from our website, 7 days' notice must be given to SASA North District after which the data will be removed.

Data Protection

In order to operate this meet, we have a legitimate interest to collect and process some basic personal data from all competitors, specifically name, gender, date of birth. This data will be held securely and only used for the purposes of managing the meet and reporting results. Dates of Birth (DOB) will only be shared with:

- Scottish Swimming for the purpose of maintaining the National Database which is used for Squad Selection and
- Swim England for inclusion on Rankings

Names, eligibility category and age (not DOB) will be retained and will be shared with attending clubs and may be published for the purpose of reporting and keeping records.

Technical Swimsuits

Swimmers 13 years and younger can **not** now compete wearing technical suits in Scottish Swimming licensed or registered events. For further information and FAQ's see Swimsuits | Scottish Swimming

Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy

As of the 1st January 2024 the Scottish Swimming Transgender & Non-Binary Competition Policy will be implemented nationally across all aquatics sports. The policy and FAQs can be found <u>HERE</u>. Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event.

As a result of this policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.

Additional Notes

All swimmers entered must have paid their SASA membership fee for the current year. Registration numbers must be shown on entry files. A Licence has been granted for this competition and accreditation will be applied for to the SASA.

All participants should adhere to the Scottish Swimming Code of Ethics, and relevant codes of conduct.

Different persons have authority and overall responsibility for the running of the meet at different stages. A list will be issued prior to the competition detailing whom you should approach with any queries, concerns or complaints during the various stages of the meet.

No guarantee can be given by SASA North District that these Championships will take place at the time and dates. SASA North District reserves the right to reschedule the event without notice and without liability for doing so. It is expected that this would only happen as a result of unforeseen circumstances, e.g. venue/facility failure or adverse weather.

In the event of postponement, cancellation or abandonment of the Championships, refunds, if any, will be made at the absolute discretion of SASA North District, who will have no legal liability to make a refund or to pay any form of consequential or indirect damage such as loss of enjoyment, travel and accommodation costs.

Eligibility

All Competitors must be registered as members of a swimming club affiliated to the SASA North District or SASA Midland District at the time of entry. **Entry standards are as attached and these are open age group standards.**

Competitors in WPS Classification S1 - S13 must have an authorised British Swimming or WPS classification, which is held on the Scottish Swimming Membership database at the time of entry.

Competitors in Classification S14 must have an authorised WPS, INAS-FID or UKSAPLD classification which is held on the Scottish Swimming Membership database at the time of entry.

Para swimmers must be identified as such with their classification at the point of entry.

General

- A copy of information held on the Scottish Swimming Membership database must be submitted to the Recording desk prior to the start of the session with the athlete's first event. No further submission is required following this. Any concerns about this, please speak to the Meet Convenor.
- All eligible swimmers will be integrated into the event seeded by absolute time.
- Where relevant, the competition shall take place under the relevant WP Swimming, Swimming Rules.
- Personal care attendants will only be permitted for swimmers in the following classes: S1, S2, S3, S4 and S11. A swimmer in any of the classes as specified above may have both a coach and personal care attendant(s) present.

- 2. Each Club's submission for ALL sessions should comply with North District **Swimming Regulation 6.3.1** as follows:-

1 – 5 swimmers No Technical Officials required, but please return the form duly marked

6 – 10 swimmers 1 Technical Official for every session of the Meet

11 – 15 swimmers 2 Technical Officials for every session, at least one of which must be Judge 1 or Recorder

16 – 20 swimmers 2 Technical Officials for every session, at least one of which must be Judge 1 or Recorder and another must be Judge 2 or above or an AOE Operator

21 – 30 swimmers 3 Technical Officials for every session, at least one of which must be Judge 1 or Recorder and another must be Judge 2 or above or an AOE Operator 4 Technical Officials for every session, at least one of which must be Judge 1 or Recorder and another must be Judge 2 or above or an AOE Operator

31 – 40 swimmers 4 Technical Officials for every session, at least one of which must be Judge 1 or Recorder and another must be Judge 2 or above or an AOE Operator 5 Technical Officials for every session, at least one of which must be Judge 1 or Recorder and another must be Judge 2 or above or an AOE Operator

Please note that the number of swimmers is the number entered into the meet not the number in a session and that these are the minimum requirements, extra officials are always welcome.

- 3. For the purposes of Rule SW6.2 Trainee Judge 1 will count as Timekeeper, and Trainee Judge 2 & 2S count as Judge, however Trainees being mentored on the day will not count towards their club's provision of officials for the purposes of Rule SW6.5
 - SW6.6 Where the Referees in charge agree that there were sufficient Swimming Technical Officials present to ensure adequate cover in any session, an official might be mentored at the next level for which they were training without incurring a penalty for that session, even although this may technically leave their Club short of the numbers required to meet SW6.2. Officials carrying out scheduled Final Assessments will count at their existing level.
- 4. For the purpose of determining how many swimmers a Club has entered into this Championships, only swimmers entered into individual events shall be counted in accordance with North District SW 6.4
