Withdrawals from Finals	Swimmers who wish to withdraw from a final must inform the recorder (at the desk outside the timing room) and complete the withdrawal form no later than 30 minutes after the list of finalists have been published or announced. This will ensure that a reserve can be given the opportunity to compete, and the final seeded accordingly.
