<u>Relay Teams:</u>	Mixed relays comprising two male and two female swimmers. Swimmers cannot swim down an age group but can swim up an age group. Maximum two teams per relay event. Entry times are not required for relay teams. Team lines must be submitted at least 45 minutes before the start of the session					
<u>Medals:</u>	Medals will be presented to 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd places and a 4 th placed pennant awarded. These can be collected after the event at the desk. A trophy will be awarded for the best 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12 year old in each category

<u>Eligibility to</u> <u>Enter</u>	All swimmers must be SASA registered and numbers must be displayed on the entry files.					

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- ConsiderationNo consideration times have been set for this Meet. Thurso ASC reserves the right to
restrict the number of heats in any event(s), reserves the right to swim a slower heat for
their swimmers and to fill any empty lanes with Thurso ASC swimmers. Heats will be
swum slowest to fastest. Entries to the events will be restricted and will be accepted
based on entry times. Any entry not accepted will be refunded.
Entries will not be accepted from composite teams.
- <u>Officials</u> Technical Officials are required to ensure the Meet achieves accreditation. All Clubs must provide a list of officials willing to help on the day. Where possible attending clubs should provide at least one judge <u>per session</u> in addition to time-keepers. Probationary Officials requiring mentoring should make this request when names are submitted. Any queries or changes should be directed to Linzey Macdougall.

competition with any matters being resolved post event.

As a result of this Policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.



Important Information:

All participants are required to adhere to the Scottish Swimming Code of Ethics, and relevant Codes of Conduct.

A Licence has been granted for this competition and accreditation will be applied for through SASA North District.

Poolside/changing room access will be limited to team coaches/chaperones. A **maximum of 1 Coach/chaperone per 10 swimmers** will be allowed on poolside at any one time.

All belongings should be placed in the lockers provided.

No outdoor shoes permitted on poolside. When moving around the spectating and reception area, footwear must be worn at all times and a t-shirt/top over costumes.

Seating areas on poolside will be allocated to each team.

Participating clubs will receive one copy of start sheets for each session. Coaches should ensure that their swimmers enter and exit the warm-ups at the allotted times. Swimmers must not enter the pool until their warm-up start is announced and must follow all instructions. Full warm up details will be issued prior to the Meet.

Over the top starts will be at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

The Meet Organisers and the facility management cannot be held responsible for items lost or damaged during the course of the event.

Clubs are responsible for clearing their seating area of belongings, litter etc before leaving at the end of the competition day.

Glass bottles, containers and hot drinks are not permitted in the pool area.
