	Distance Eve	This meet is an opportunity for North District Swimmers to gain accredited times for Distance Events and to serve as an opportunity to develop distance swimming within the North District by recognising progress.				
Meet Purpose	There is an additional opportunity for swimmers aged 11 and 12 to post times in 200m Individual Medley as required to be eligible for qualification into the Scottish Swimming Junior Academy; and for swimmers aged 13 and over to swim 100m Individual Medley because of limited opportunity to swim this event.					
Eligibility to Enter	This competition is open to swimmers who are members of SASA North District affiliated Clubs only. All events have two eligibility categories – Male & Open and Female although the events will be swum mixed.					
Swimmer SASA Membership	All swimmers entered must have paid their SASA membership fee for the current year. Registration numbers must be shown on entry files. A Licence has been granted for this competition and accreditation will be applied for to the SASA.					
Age Groups	Age groups recognised for individual events: 11/12 years, 13/14 years and 15 years and over Events will be swum with age groups and eligibility categories combined according to the programme of events. Age will be at 12 October 2025.					

Distance Events will be seeded and swum fast to slow 400m, 800m, 1500m Freestyle, 400m Individual Medley Time Trial events will be seeded and swum slow to fast 100m (13 + years only), 200m 11/12 years only)		
Time Trial events will be seeded and swum slow to fast 100m (13 + years only), 200m 11/12 years only) There are no consideration times, or slower than times, for this meet, but all entries must have an entry time. Times do not require to be accredited but should be real times achieved at accredited meets, non-accredited meets or club time trials. No time entries will not be accepted. Accepted entries may have to be limited dependent upon numbers received in which case entries will be accepted across age groups as evenly as is practical. All entries must be on Hy-tek Team Manager entry file (ND Rule SW 4.1), Events files may be obtained by downloading from the North District website (www.sasanorth.org.uk). 	All Swimmers must present themselves to the marshal before their events and are advised to attend in good time. The start of a race will not be delayed for absent competitors.
Marshalling	Swimmers may report to marshalling for more than one event where it is deemed that there will be insufficient time between races to marshal in good time for their next event. It is for the swimmer to inform the marshal if they are reporting for more than one event.
	Swimmers who have not presented themselves to the marshals prior to their heat leaving the last marshalling area will not be permitted to swim, will be treated as a late withdrawal and may be fined accordingly.
Reserves	Reserves must present themselves to the marshal unless they have withdrawn.

	Failing to submit the form in accordance with these conditions will be considered a failure to submit the form. North District rules SW 6.2 and SW4.1 refer.
Technical Swimsuits	Swimmers 13 years and younger cannot now compete wearing technical suits in Scottish Swimming licensed or registered events. For further information and FAQ's see Swimsuits Scottish Swimming
Transgender & Non-Binary	The Scottish Swimming Transgender & Non-Binary Competition Policy is now in place. Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Meet Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event.
	By entering the Female category, swimmers are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.
Photos & Videos	The use of mobile phones or other devices capable of taking photographs or videos is strictly forbidden in the changing village, shower areas, toilets and first aid rooms. Protection	 Scottish Swimming for the purpose of maintaining the National Database which is used for Squad Selection and Swim England for inclusion on Rankings SASA North District/Clubs - Names, eligibility category and age (not DOB) will be retained and will be shared with attending clubs and may be published for the purpose of reporting and keeping records.
Clean Sport	Please note that anti-doping may be in operation at any level 1 licensed event. All swimmers registered with Scottish Swimming will have signed a clean sport agreement at point or membership registration/renewal.
Conduct	All swimmers, team staff, technical officials and spectators should adhere to the Scottish Swimming Code of Ethics, and relevant codes of conduct.
Competition Management	Different persons have authority and overall responsibility for the running of the Competition at different stages. A list will be included in the participant information which will be issued prior to the competition detailing whom you should approach with any queries, concerns or complaints during the various stages of the competition.

Each Club's submission for ALL sessions should comply with North District Swimming Regulation 6.3.1 as follows:

Total number of club swimmers at the competition	Number of officials per session
1 – 5	None
6 – 10	One official
11 – 20	Two officials at least one of which must be Judge 1 or Recorder
21 – 30	Three officials at least one of which must be Judge 1 or Recorder and another must be Judge 2 or above, or an AOE Operator
31 – 40	Four officials at least two of which must be Judge 1 or Recorder and one more must be Judge 2 or above, or an AOE Operator
41+	Five officials at least two of which must be Judge 1 or Recorder and another must be Judge 2 or above, or an AOE Operator

Please note that the number of swimmers is the number entered into the meet not the number in a session and that these are the minimum requirements, extra officials are always welcome.

For the purposes of Rule SW6.2 Trainee Judge 1 will count as Timekeeper, and Trainee Judge 2 & 2S count as Judge, however Trainees being mentored on the day will not count towards their club's provision of officials for the purposes of Rule SW6.5

SW6.6 Where the Referees in charge agree that there were sufficient Swimming Technical Officials present to ensure adequate cover in any session, an official might be mentored at the next level for which they were training without incurring a penalty for that session, even although this may technically leave their Club short of the numbers required to meet SW6.2.

For the purpose of determining how many swimmers a Club has entered into a North District Meet or Championships, only swimmers entered into individual events shall be counted in accordance with SW 6.4.
