Age Groups:	8 yrs, 9 yrs, 10 yrs, 11 yrs, 12 yrs. Age on the day.					
Events:	8 yrs: 25m Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke and Freestyle					
	9, 10, 11 & 12 years: 50m Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke and Freestyle					
	4x50 Freestyle Relay: Boys & Open, Female 4x50 Medley Relay: Boys & Open, Female					
	Events will be swum combined age groups, but awards will be for each age group.					
	Girls' events will be in Session 1 and Boys & Open events in Session 2.					
Relay Teams:	For all relays, the team should comprise 1 swimmer from age 12 yrs, 11 yrs, 10 yrs & 9/8 yrs. Swimmers cannot swim down an age group but can swim up an age group. Clubs can enter up to 2 relays per relay event. Entry times are not required for relay teams. Team lines must be submitted <b>at least 45 minutes</b> before the start of the session.					
Awards:	There will be awards for the top 3 swimmers/teams in each event. There will be an award for the top female and male & open teams, based on points. Relay teams will score double points. Points will be awarded from 12 for a 1 <sup>st</sup> place down to 1 for a 12 <sup>th</sup> place.

### **General Information**

- 1. Competitors must be SASA registered and numbers must be displayed on the entry files.
- All entries must have an entry time, either an accredited time or training time. Any "no time" (NT) entries will be rejected and no refund will be made, apart for relay events which can be entered with NT.
- 3. All events are Heat Declared Winner.
- 4. The Meet Convenor retains the right to change warm-up times if necessary.
- 5. Manual timekeeping will be used.
- 6. Swimmers must report to marshalling 4 heats before their heat.
- 7. There will be no presentations for individual/relay events and swimmers should collect their awards from the medals table. The top club awards will be presented at the end of the session.
- 8. Any person wishing to take videos or photographs must sign a form at the recorder's table.
- 9. Phones must be switched off in the changing rooms and turned to silent in the pool hall.
- 10. 1 coach per 10 swimmers will be allowed in the pool hall.
- 11. Swimmers should wear club kit and pool shoes on the poolside.
- 12. Swimmers 13 years and younger cannot compete wearing technical suits in Scottish Swimming licensed or registered events. - 13. As of the 1st January 2024 the Scottish Swimming Transgender & Non-Binary Competition Policy was implemented nationally across all aquatics sports. Information can be found at:

Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event.

As a result of this policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.
