	This competition is intended to be a friendly, welcoming opportunity for learning. We want the

	accepted on a first com-	e first served basis with whole club entries accepted up to the maximum		
	permitted by the facility. If, for the final club acceptance, we are only able to accommodate a part of			
	a club's entries we will let the club know and ask them what they would like to do. For clubs and			
	swimmers that are over	subscribed, some reserve spaces will be offered.		
WHO OUR MEET IS	The meet is for young and developing swimmers aged 7 to 11.			
FOR	Age as at 25 th May 2025 for all events.			
	Age Groups for all individual events are 7/8, 9, 10, 11			
	7/8 and 9 year old swimmers will swim in one session only, swimming short events, as an			
	introduction to competition. Females will swim in the morning and male & open will swim in the			
	afternoon.			
	10 and 11 year old swimmers, female, and male & open, will swim in both sessions and a wider			
	range of events will be offered

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CONDITIONS

Age as at 25th May 2025 for all events.

There are no consideration times for this meet and no time entries will be accepted. Swimmers will be seeded fastest to slowest in each event, with no time entries seeded as slowest.

Relay events are open to all age groups, and we reserve the right to only allow 2 relay teams per club, depending on entries (but can fill heats with a third Alford Team).

Because this competition is intended to be a friendly, welcoming opportunity for learning for young swimmers, the full technical rules of swimming will not be applied. The meet will be run under the following conditions:

Forward facing starts with a dive from the blocks, from the side or from in the water will all be permitted.

Swimmers will only be disqualified for the following:

- Starting before the signal (although a restart will usually be offered) or doing a "flyer" in a relay
- Swimming the wrong stroke in either an individual event or a relay
- Not completing the full distance (including not touching the end at a turn)
- Actions that are against the rules AND gain a clear unfair advantage eg pulling on the lane rope or swimming underwater

Technical officials will record any technical infractions observed, and these will be shared with relevant club coaches after the session to assist swimmers with their development in training.

ENTRIES

This is a club meet, and entries will not be accepted from composite teams.

All entries must be on Hy-tek Team Manager entry file.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES IS FRIDAY 25 APRIL 2025 OR WHENEVER THE MEET IS FULL, WHICHEVER COMES FIRST

All paperwork, entry files and payment must be received by this date.

Team lines will be required one hour before the start of the session in which the relay takes place and only those swimmers that have been accepted into the meet can take part in relays.

INDIVIDUAL	There will be medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in individual events and relays.			
AWARDS	Flashes will be provided for all those who take part.			
MARSHALLING	Marshalling will take place through the changing rooms and into the disabled suite.			
	All swimmers must attend marshalling before their events and are advised to attend in good time.			
	4 heats in advance is the minimum suggested.			
WITHDRAWALS	Withdrawals from swimmers prior to the competition should be emailed to			
	ottersentries@gmail.com to arrive no later than 5pm on Thursday 22 nd May 2025.			
	Withdrawals after this time should be submitted to the recorders table prior to the start			
	of each warm up on the withdrawal forms made available.			
	Refunds for swimmers who are withdrawing through illness or injury will be granted only if the			
	swimmer has been withdrawn in time according to the meet information and when the			
	swimmer can provide medical evidence confirming that they are unfit to swim to the Meet			
	Convenor within 7 days following the Meet. The letter should be dated not more than 4 weeks			
	before the Meet and not more than 2 days after the meet.			
	No other refunds will be available.			
PHOTOGRAPHY	Please note that anyone wishing to use photographic equipment, including video cameras, tablets			
	and mobile phones must register with the Meet Convenor using the form that will be made			
	available with the participant information.			
MOBILE PHONES	Mobile phones may not be used under any circumstances in the shower area, toilets and changing			
	rooms. They must be switched to silent in the pool hall and can only be used for photography if			
	they have been registered as above.			



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SWIMSUIT	Please note that as of 1st September 2022, new regulations came into force regarding technical			
REGULATIONS	swimsuits. From this date, all swimmers aged 13 years and under cannot compete wearing technical

COMPETITION	event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these			
POLICY	matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming staff.			
	At no point will members be challenged on the day of the competition with any matters being			
	resolved post event. Clubs must confirm that swimmers entering the female category were born			
	female.			
NOTES	All swimmers entered must have paid their SASA memberships fees for the current year			
	with registration numbers shown on entry files.			
	Poolside access will be limited to 1 member of club staff per 8 swimmers.			
	No food is to be eaten in the changing rooms and lunches are not to be eaten poolside. No			
	glassware should be taken into the changing rooms or onto poolside.			
	The dining hall will be available for swimmers and club staff for lunch. The changing rooms			
	will be closed over lunchtime.			
	Participating clubs will receive one copy of start sheets for each session. Results			
	will be posted at the pool during the event and after the event will be sent via e-			
	mail and published on the North District website.			
	Technical Officials will be offered light lunch. Coaches and Team Managers can			
	request lunch at a cost of £7 per head and requests should be submitted with the			
	summary sheet and payment included with entries.			
	Spectating is available but the view may be limited.
