<b>POOL</b>	25 Metres, 6 Lanes, 2 metres deep, anti-turbulence ropes, starting Blocks at start end only, backstroke ledges, deck Level Pool
<b>SESSIONS</b>	Session One: Warm Up 08:15 - Start 09:20 – Approx Finish 12.20 Session Two: Warm Up 13:00 - Start 14:05 – Approx Finish 17:05 (Subject to change if necessary)
<b>EVENTS</b>	<p>Individual Events - 8 Years: 50m Back, Breast, Butterfly &amp; Freestyle &amp; 100IM 9-16 Years: 100m Back, Breast, Butterfly &amp; Freestyle &amp; 100IM Team Events - 8 x 50m Freestyle &amp; Medley cannon relays.</p> <p>The relays will consist of 8x50m freestyle and medley events – teams must include four boys and four girls and the total of the swimmers ages on the day of the meet must not exceed 100 years. Relay team members must also be swimming in an individual event. Each club may enter up to two teams in each relay event.</p> <p>The medley relay will be swum in the order: <b>Back, breast, fly, free, back breast, fly, free. Swimmers 1 &amp; 5 will start in the pool.</b></p> <p>Please note we will have 'HOT HEATS' throughout the day. These will be chosen at random, and a prize awarded to the winner of that heat. Swimmers will be notified of this prior to the start of the heat by music and the announcer will clarify this is a HOT HEAT.</p> <p>No Swimmer under the age of 8 is permitted to swim. Entries will not be accepted from composite teams.</p>
<b>AGE</b>	All events are age on the day (3 <sup>rd</sup> May 2025)
<b>AWARDS</b>	<p>Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, &amp; 3<sup>rd</sup> places for the following – Age groups - 8, 9, 10, 11-12, 13-14 &amp; 15-16 for 50m, 100m &amp; 100IM.</p> <p>There will be no medal presentations during the event. Medals will be available for collection from the medals desk which will be located in the foyer.</p>

<b>ENTRIES</b>	<p><b>All entries must be on Hy-tek Team Manager entry file</b> (District Rule SW 4.1.). In the event of an oversubscription, entries will be accepted as evenly across the programme as is practical.</p> <p>A Draft Programme will be emailed to all participating clubs no later than 7 days after closing date.</p> <p><b>Closing Date: Friday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2025</b></p> <p>Please note Summary Sheet and Payment must be received within 3 postal days of closing date. There will be zero tolerance of late payment. Any entry or payment not received within the timeframe will be rejected without delay. <b>WITHDRAWALS ON THE DAY</b>	Withdrawals on the day should be submitted on the withdrawal forms made available and should be presented to the Recorders table at least 1 hour prior to the start of the first session and updated accordingly one hour before the start of each session thereafter.
<b>REFUNDS</b>	<p>No refunds will be made once draft programme is issued.</p> <p>Refunds for swimmers who withdraw through illness or injury, will only be considered where medical evidence confirming that they are unable to swim is received no later than 7 days following the meet.</p> <p>In the event of postponement, cancellation or abandonment of the event, refunds will be made at the absolute discretion of Broch ASC</p>
<b>CONSIDERATION TIMES</b>	<p>Consideration times have been set for this meet (apart from 50m races) Broch ASC reserves the right to restrict the number of heats in any event(s), to swim a slower heat for their Swimmers and to fill any empty lanes with Broch ASC Swimmers.</p> <p>Heats will be swum slowest to fastest. Entries to the events will be restricted and will be accepted based on entry times. Times do not need to be accredited but must be submitted for seeding purposes. NT entries will NOT be accepted. <b>MARSHALLING</b>	Marshalling will be at the trainer pool beside the entrance to the changing village. All swimmers must attend marshalling before their events and are advised to attend in good time. The start of a race will not be delayed for absent swimmers who have not presented themselves to the marshalls in time, they will not be permitted to swim.

From this date, all swimmers aged 13 years and younger cannot compete wearing technical suits in Scottish Swimming licenced or registered events. <b>TRANSGENDER POLICY</b>	<p>As of the 1st January 2024 the Scottish Swimming Transgender &amp; Non-Binary Competition Policy was implemented nationally across all aquatics sports. The policy and FAQs can be found here: (<a href="http://www.scottishswimming.com/about-us/equality">www.scottishswimming.com/about-us/equality</a>) Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event. As a result of this policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.</p>

<b>IMPORTANT INFORMATION</b>	<p>All swimmers entered must have paid their SASA membership fee for the current year.</p> <p>All participants are required to adhere to the Scottish Swimming Code of Ethics, and relevant codes of conduct.</p> <p>A Licence has been granted for this competition and accreditation will be applied for through SASA North District.</p> <p>Each competitor should bring (as a minimum): Sufficient water in a plastic water bottle(s), shorts &amp; t-shirt to wear over the swimsuit/swim shorts at all times when not swimming, poolside shoes (e.g. crocs/clean trainers/flip flops).</p> <p>Poolside/changing room access will be limited to team coaches and chaperones up to a maximum of one coach/chaperone per 10 swimmers, with a maximum of 3 coaches/chaperones at any one time.</p> <p>Belongings should be placed in the lockers provided, any left in changing cubicles will be removed by pool staff.</p> <p>Seating areas will be allocated to each team. Teams are responsible for ensuring that their swimmers recognize the importance of "giving people space", especially when moving through the seating and marshalling areas.</p> <p>Participating clubs will receive one copy of start sheets for each session.</p> <p>Coaches should ensure that their swimmers enter and exit the warmups at the allotted times. Swimmers must not enter the pool until their warm-up start is announced and must follow all instructions. Full warm up details will be issued prior to the meet.</p> <p>Over the top starts will be used when applicable. The Gala Convenor reserves the right to alter the meet programme and warm up times if necessary.</p> <p>The meet organisers and the facility management cannot be held responsible for items lost or damaged during the course of the event.</p> <p>Clubs are responsible for clearing their seating area of belongings, litter, etc. before leaving at the end of the competition day. Bin liners for plastic bottles/recyclable items and for general waste will be distributed around the pool - please use them.</p> <p>Glass bottles, containers and hot drinks are not permitted in the pool area.</p>
