Awards:	Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in each individual Age Group for 25m, 50m, and 100lM.  Medals can be collected from the medal table, located by the results in the Spinning Room.							
	There will be a best Boy / Girl prize for each individual age group.  There will be a best 'Buckie ASC' 10 Year old Boy and Girl trophies awarded.  These will be decided on a points basis, 1 <sup>st</sup> place 6 points, 2 <sup>nd</sup> place 5 points, 3 <sup>rd</sup> place 4 points, 4 <sup>th</sup> place 3 points 5 <sup>th</sup> place 2 points, 6 <sup>th</sup> place 1 point.

At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event. As a result of this policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.		
Consideration Times	There are no consideration times for this meet. Buckie ASC reserves the right to restrict the number of heats in any event(s), to swim a slower heat for their Swimmers and to fill any empty lanes with Buckie ASC Swimmers. Heats will be swum slowest to fastest Heats may be restricted to run the meet within time limits as per District regulations. No NT entries will be accepted. Any entry not accepted will be refunded. 	2. A Licence has been granted for this competition and accreditation will be applied fo through SASA North District.				
	3. Each competitor should bring (as a minimum): • Sufficient water in a plastic water bottle(s); • Shorts & t-shirt to wear over the swimsuit/swim shorts at all times when not swimming; • Poolside shoes (e.g. crocs/clean trainers/flip flops);				
	4. Poolside/changing room access will be limited to team coaches and chaperones up to a maximum of one coach/chaperone per 10 swimmers, with a maximum of 3 coaches/chaperones at any one time.				
	5. Belongings should be placed in the lockers provided.				
	6. Seating areas will be allocated to each team.				
	7. Participating clubs will receive one copy of start sheets for each session.				
	8. Coaches should ensure that their swimmers enter and exit the warm ups at the allotted times. Swimmers must not enter the pool until their warm-up start is announced and must follow all instructions. Full warm up details will be issued prior to the meet.				
	9. Over the top starts will be issued at the discretion of the Meet Referee.				
	10. The meet organisers and the facility management cannot be held responsible for items lost or damaged during the course of the event.				
	11. Clubs are responsible for clearing their seating area of belongings, litter, etc. before leaving at the end of the competition day. Bin liners for plastic bottles/recyclable items and for general waste will be distributed around the pool please use them.
