Rooms within the Deveron Centre will be available for officials to store personal belongings and for lunches for all participants. Car Parking is available at Banff academy next to the Deveron Centre.

CONSIDERATION TIMES

No consideration times have been set for this meet. Deveron ASC reserves the right to restrict the number of heats in any event(s), reserves the right to swim a slower heat for their swimmers and to fill

any empty lanes with Deveron ASC swimmers. Heats will be swum slowest to fastest. Entries to the events will be restricted and will be accepted based on entry times. Any entry not accepted will be refunded.

ACCREDITATION

Application for accreditation is being made to the North District under SASA rules therefore all competitors must be members of SASA. Checks will be made prior to the meet. Registration numbers must be shown on entry files.

ENTRIES

£7.50 per individual event. £9.00 per relay.

Payment by BACS is preferred to Sort code: 80-08-92 Account: 00273507 (Reference should be SUMMER25 followed by the club code e.g. SUMMER25NDNX).

Closing Date for Entries is 29th August 2025

All entries must be on Hy-tek Team Manager entry file (District Rule SW 4.1.). Entry files may be obtained by downloading from the North District website (<u>www.sasanorth.org.uk</u>) or contact Emma Hartshorn at meetsecretary.dasc@gmail.com.

Entries may have to be limited dependent upon numbers received. In the event that the meet is oversubscribed, entries will be accepted as evenly across the programme as is practical.

Draft Programme will be emailed to all participating clubs, with notice of entries/scratches. After this time no withdrawals for refund will be accepted unless notice of Doctors Note is given within 7 days after the meet.

Summary Sheet and Payment must be received within 3 postal days of closing date

As of the 1st January 2024 the Scottish Swimming Transgender & Non-Binary Competition Policy was implemented nationally across all aquatics sports. The policy and FAQs can be found HERE. Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event.

As a result of this policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.

WITHDRAWALS

Withdrawals prior to the competition should be emailed to the above email address no later than 5pm on Friday 19th September. Please email any known withdrawals as soon as possible so that reserves can be informed.

Withdrawals on the day should be notified to the recorders desk at least 20 minutes prior to the start of the appropriate session.

REFUNDS

Refunds for any scratched or unachieved reserve swims will be made by BACs transfer within 4 weeks of the meet. Please make sure that appropriate account information is supplied on the summary sheet for this to happen efficiently. If a cheque payment is preferred, please indicate this with the Entry information.

MEDALS

Medals will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.

START SHEETS

Participating clubs will receive one copy of start sheets per session. Additional copies will be at the discretion of the Referee.

TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

Lists of Technical Officials for all sessions can be entered on the attached sheet and must be emailed to dascmeetsec@outlook.com with the meet entry.

Lunch will be provided for Officials and available for purchase for coaches/poolside helpers. Please see Summary Sheet of information.

CAMERAS/VIDEOS/PHOTO MOBILE PHONES

Photographic permission will **not** be issued for any devices.

The use of mobile phones or electronic devices capable of taking videos or photos is only permitted in designated areas and will not be permitted in the changing areas, showers and toilets, in order to prevent any misuse of mobiles with integrated digital camera/video equipment. No photos or videos should be taken or uploaded in these areas.

We would be grateful if you could ensure that all members of your club are aware of these requirements.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. All participants are required to adhere to the Scottish Swimming Code of Ethics, and relevant codes of conduct.
- 2. Each competitor should bring (as a minimum):
 - a. Sufficient water in a plastic water bottle(s);
 - b. Shorts & t-shirt to wear over the swimsuit/swim shorts at all times when not swimming;
 - c. Poolside shoes (e.g. crocs/clean trainers/flip flops);
 - d. Hand sanitiser.
- 3. Poolside/changing room access will be limited to team coaches and chaperones up to a maximum of one coach/chaperone per 10 swimmers, with a maximum of 3 coaches/chaperones at any one time.
- 4. Belongings should be placed in the lockers provided.
- 5. Seating areas will be allocated to each team.
- 6. Coaches should ensure that their swimmers enter and exit the warm ups at the allotted times. Swimmers must not enter the pool until their warm-up start is announced and must follow all instructions. Full warm up details will be issued prior to the meet.
- 7. The meet organisers and the facility management cannot be held responsible for items lost or damaged during the course of the event.
- 8. Clubs are responsible for clearing their seating area of belongings, litter, etc. before leaving at the end of the competition day. Bin liners for plastic bottles/recyclable items and for general waste will be distributed around the pool please use them.
- 9. Glass bottles, containers and hot drinks are not permitted in the pool area.
