Early Withdrawals:	Withdrawals prior to the event to be emailed: elginascentries@gmail.com to arrive by 5pm at the latest on Thursday 20th February 2025 . NB: All details must be included on e-mail withdrawals i.e. Name, Event No, Stroke, Comp No etc. Telephone withdrawals will not be accepted.
Withdrawals on the Day:	Withdrawals from heats should be notified to the recorders desk at least 20 minutes prior to the start of the appropriate session.
Marshalling	There will be marshalling. All swimmers must attend marshalling before their events and are advised to attend in good time. The start of a race will not be delayed for absent swimmers who have not presented themselves to the marshals prior to their heat leaving. Late swimmers will not be permitted to swim.
Awards:	There will be medals. No medal ceremony apart from 'Skins' prize winners. Medals will be distributed by Gala Convenor. Skins Event Winners only will be awarded with a 'Skins' Cap and a prize of £50 cash for each final winner(s) of Round 3 only .

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Photography:	No photographic or video equipment will be allowed in any area without the prior approval of the Meet Convenor. Photographic QR codes will be used for this meet. The use of mobile phones/photographic/video equipment is not permitted at any time in the changing area, showers, or toilets. All phones must be switched to silent on the pool deck.
Technical Swimsuits	Swimmers 13 years and younger cannot compete wearing technical suits in Scottish Swimming licensed or registered events. See Swimwear Scottish Swimming
Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy	From 1st January 2024 the Scottish Swimming Transgender & Non-Binary Competition Policy will be implemented nationally across all aquatics sports. See Equality Scottish Swimming Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event. As a result of this policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.

Important Information:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All participants are required to adhere to the Scottish Swimming Code of Ethics, and relevant codes of conduct. 2. A Licence has been granted for this competition and accreditation will be applied for through SASA North District. 3. Each competitor should bring (as a minimum): • Sufficient water in a plastic water bottle(s); • Shorts & t-shirt to wear over the swimsuit/swim shorts at all times when not swimming; • Poolside shoes (e.g. crocs/clean trainers/flip flops). 4. Poolside/changing room access will be limited to team coaches/chaperones up to a maximum of one coach/chaperone per 10 swimmers, with a maximum of 3 coaches/chaperones at any one time. 5. Belongings should be placed in the lockers provided. 6. Seating areas will be allocated to each team. Teams are responsible for ensuring that their swimmers recognize the importance of “giving people space”, especially when moving through the seating and marshalling areas. 7. Participating clubs will receive one copy of start sheets for each session. 8. Coaches should ensure that their swimmers enter and exit the warm-ups at the allotted times. Swimmers must not enter the pool until their warm-up start is announced and must follow all instructions. Full warm up details will be issued prior to the meet. 9. Over the top starts will be issued at the discretion of the Meet Referee. 10. The meet organisers and the facility management cannot be held responsible for items lost or damaged during the course of the event.

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	<p>11. Clubs are responsible for clearing their seating area of belongings, litter, etc. before leaving at the end of the competition day. Bin liners for plastic bottles/recyclable items and for general waste will be distributed around the pool - please use them.</p> <p>12. Glass bottles, containers and hot drinks are not permitted in the pool area.</p> <p>13. There will be limited spectating to allow maximum number of swimmers.</p>
