Swimsuit Regulations	Please note that as of 1 st September 2022, new regulations came into force regarding technical swimsuits. From this date, all swimmers aged 13 years and younger cannot compete wearing technical suits in Scottish Swimming licenced or registered events. A	Age is as on day of competition i.e. 7 th September 2025.		
Age	Age is as on day of competition i.e. 7 ^{or} September 2023. Age Groups for 25m events for Female and Male & Open will be 7 and 8 years. These heats will be swum as single sex with swimmers seeded by entry times.		
	Age Groups for 50m events for Female and Male & Open will be 9, 10 and 11 years. These heats will be swum as single sex with all age groups combined and swimmers seeded by entry times.		
	Age Groups for 100m Individual Medley for Female and Male & Open will be 7 – 11 years. The 100m Individual Medley will be swum as one event per sex with all age groups combined and swimmers seeded by entry times. There will be only one set of medals for this event.		
	Age Groups for Relay events will be 7 – 11 years. Relays will be swum with mixed age teams with a maximum of two swimmers aged 11, with two younger swimmers making up the team. Teams must be made up of 2 Male & Open and 2 Female. Each club can enter a maximum of two relay teams in each event – swimmers must have been entered for at least one individual swim and they may only swim in one team per relay event.		
	Medals will be awarded to the first three places in age group. There will be no medal presentation, but medals can be collected from the designated table in the foyer.

These should be real times, that may come from a Club's own time trials, but do not need to be accredited. Please note that NT times will not be accepted. In the event that the meet is oversubscribed cuts will be made based on swimmers wit the fewest swims in a session, regardless of where they lie in the seedings, followed the cuts for the slowest times. In the event the meet is under subscribed late entries will accepted on a case by case basis. Withdrawals	Withdrawals prior to the meet should be emailed to <u>meetsec@gasc.co.uk</u> to arrive no later than 12noon on Thursday 4th September 2025 .
	All details must be included on e-mail withdrawals i.e. Name, Event No, Stroke, SASA No. etc. Telephone withdrawals will not be accepted under any circumstances.
	Withdrawals on the day should be submitted on the withdrawal forms made available and should be presented to the Recorders table at least 1 hour prior to the start of the appropriate session.
	Please note that for anyone withdrawing on medical grounds, refunds will only be granted on production of a letter from a suitably qualified professional confirming withdrawal is recommended. The letter must be received within 7 days following the meet and should be dated no earlier than the closing date or later than 3 days from the date of the competition.

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Special	Please note that this meet is intended for novice swimmers who have either never		
Conditions	 competed, or who are relatively new to competitive swimmers who have either never competed, or who are relatively new to competitive swimming. It will be run in an encouraging and supportive environment and the full World Aquatic rules of swimming will not be applied. The meet will therefore be run under the following conditions: Forward facing starts with a dive from the blocks, or from in the water will all be permitted 		
	 Swimmers will only be disqualified for the following: Starting before the signal (although a restart will usually be offered) or doing a "flyer" in a relay Swimming the wrong stroke in either an individual event or a relay Not completing the full distance (including not touching the end at a turn) Actions that are against the rules AND gain a clear and unfair advantage, eg. Pulling on the lane rope or swimming underwater. 		
	Although a novice meet, coaches should ensure that swimmers are capable of completing a stroke/distance according to World Aquatic technical requirements before entering swimmers into an event.		
	Any swimmer with existing North District times or achieving North District times or entering a North District event after submission of the entry must be withdrawn from all swims and their entry fees will be refunded.		
	We would like to encourage clubs to enter relay teams to promote team spirit and fun at this novice event.		
Marshalling	There will be marshalling located on poolside by the training pool, subject to change. All swimmers must attend marshalling before their events and are advised to attend in good time. The start of the race will not be delayed for absent competitors.		
Photography Mobile Phones	Please note that anyone wishing to use photographic equipment, including video cameras, must register with the Meet Convener on the appropriate form. Garioch ASC may take photographs for use with club publicity. The Garioch WPO will approve all such photographs. Please contact the Meet Convener should you not wish for your swimmer's photograph to be taken. Mobile phones must not be used in the changing rooms.		
Meet Regulations	No guarantee can be given by GASC that the event will take place at a particular time or any particular date and GASC reserves the right to reschedule or cancel the event without notice and liability for doing so. It is expected that this would only happen as a result of unforeseen circumstances e.g. COVID-19 outbreak, events of national importance, venue/facility failure or adverse weather. Garioch ASC will have no legal liability to make any refund or to pay any form of consequential or indirect damage such as loss of enjoyment, travel and accommodation costs should the meet be required to be cancelled or changed.		
	This event is run in accordance with Scottish Swimming Competition Management Guidance and codes of conduct prevailing at the time of the event; requirements for the meet may need to be changed in accordance with any change in regulations/legislation. A risk assessment has been carried out and takes into consideration the information contained within this document.		



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Transgender & Non-Binary Competition Policy	As of the 1st January 2024 the Scottish Swimming Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy was implemented nationally across all aquatics sports. The policy and FAQs can be found at https://www.scottishswimming.com/about-us/equality. Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event. As a result of this policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.

Notes	 All swimmers, poolside helpers and coaches taking part should have a current SASA membership. Registration numbers must be shown on entry files. A license has been applied for and accreditation will be applied for with SASA. Poolside access will be limited to one Coach per 10 swimmers, with a maximum of 3 Coaches at any one time. Meal tickets for lunch are available for coaches at £6 per person per day – please include within the summary sheet provided. Outdoor shoes will need to be removed before entering the changing rooms and there are shoe racks at the entrance to the changing village to allow this. Belongings should be placed in the lockers provided within the changing village. No large bags are allowed on poolside due to minimal space. Each competitor should bring (as a minimum): Sufficient water in a plastic water bottle(s) – water can be refilled at the water fountain if required; Shorts & t-shirt to wear over the swimsuit/swim shorts at all times when not swimming; Poolside shoes (e.g. crocs/clean trainers/flip flops) – these should be changed into prior to entering the changing village. The meet organisers and the facility management cannot be held responsible for items lost or damaged during the course of the event. Seating areas of belongings, litter etc. before leaving at the end of the competition day.
