Swimsuit Regulations	Please note that as of 1st September 2022, new regulations came into force regarding technical swimsuits. From this date, all swimmers aged 13 years and younger cannot compete wearing technical suits in Scottish Swimming licenced or registered events. Age	Age is as on last day of competition i.e., 16 th November 2025.			
	Age Groups for Male & Open and Female will be 10-13 years, 14-15 years and 16+ years. Heats will be run mixed age, seeded by entry time.			
	Points will be awarded for the top 10 places within each Individual Medley event for each age group as below. At the end of Session Four, points will be collated and the top scorer for category will be awarded a cash prize as follows:			
	Female Age 10-13 years Male & Open Age 10-13 years Female Age 14-15 years Male & Open Age 14-15 years			
	Female Age 16 years + Male & Open Age 16 years +			
	In the event of a draw, a 200IM swim-off will take place with the fastest time in the swim-off being awarded the cash prize.

Please note the entry file and summary sheet must be received by email by the closing date - **12 noon Friday 3rd October 2025.** Late entries will be accepted on a case by case basis depending upon numbers.

All entries must be on Hy-tek Team Manager entry file.

Entry files may be obtained by contacting Murray Gow at meetsec@gasc.co.uk.

Where possible the accepted entries for each age group will be equal, but if an age group is under-subscribed, the organising committee reserves the right to include additional entries in other age groups. Entries may have to be limited dependent upon numbers received.

Once all entries are received, swimmers will be seeded into their entered events fastest to slowest.

If the meet is oversubscribed, and cuts have to be made, entries will be accepted as evenly as possible across the eligibility criteria and age groups, subject to the conditions below:

Priority acceptance will be as follows:

- 1. Swimmers that have entered all three medley events will be accepted first
- 2. Swimmers that have entered two medley events will be accepted second
- 3. Swimmers that have entered one medley event will be accepted third

The 1500m event will then be accepted with entry restricted to 3 heats on each day with fastest swimmers accepted first as evenly across the age groups as possible.

Thereafter, if cuts have to be made to keep the number of swimmers to an acceptable number in any session, swimmers with the most swims in that session will be accepted.

If cuts have to be made to keep the duration of the session to an acceptable time, the fastest swimmers will be accepted first for each event as evenly as possible by age group. If any age group or event is under-subscribed, the organizing committee reserves the right to include additional entries into others.

Garioch ASC reserves the right to amend the programme at any time and to include additional Garioch swimmers in certain races to fill unused lanes/heats if entry numbers allow.

There are no consideration times, but times must be submitted on entry for seeding purposes. These should be real times, that may come from a Club's own time trials, but do not need to be accredited. Please note that NT times will not be accepted.

Traveling Clubs

Garioch ASC reserves the right to guarantee entries of up to a maximum of two clubs, where pre booked travel (i.e. flights or ferries) is required to travel to and from the event. This will be on a first come first served basis and application must be by email to Garioch ASC on meetsec@gasc.co.uk. Garioch ASC strongly recommends that no travel arrangements are confirmed until the club receives a written confirmation of entry.

Coaches Information	A Coaches' pack will be available for coaches or team managers to collect from the recorders' desk outside the timing room on the pool deck. This will include withdrawal sheets and any other relevant information.			
	Poolside access should be limited to club coaches and team managers, with up to a maximum of one coach/chaperone per 10 swimmers, with a maximum of 3 coaches/team managers at any one time.			
	Coaches and Team Managers can request meals (Lunch) at a cost of £8 per head Requests should be submitted with the summary sheet and payment must be made along with the entry fees.			
Withdrawals	Withdrawals prior to the meet should be emailed to meetsec@gasc.co.uk to arrive no later than 12noon on Thursday 13th November 2025.			
	All details must be included on e-mail withdrawals i.e. Name, Event No, Stroke, SASA No. etc. Telephone withdrawals will not be accepted under any circumstances.			
	Withdrawals on the day should be submitted on the withdrawal forms made available and should be presented to the Recorders table at least 1 hour prior to the start of the appropriate session.			
	Please note that for anyone withdrawing on medical grounds, refunds will only be granted on production of a letter from a suitably qualified professional confirming withdrawal is recommended. The letter must be received within 7 days following the meet and should be dated no earlier than the closing date or later than 3 days from the date of the competition.

Marshalling

There will be marshalling for all heats. All swimmers must attend marshalling before their events and are advised to attend in good time. The start of the race will not be delayed for absent competitors. Swimmers who have not presented themselves to the marshals prior to their heat leaving the final marshalling area will not be permitted to swim (note: for 100m events this is expected to be the stairwell to poolside next to the timing suite and for 50m events this will be adjacent to the starting blocks at the turn end).

Reserves must marshal unless they have withdrawn.

Photography Mobile Phones

Please note that anyone wishing to use photographic equipment in the pool hall, including video cameras, must register with the Meet Convener on the appropriate form. Garioch ASC may take photographs for use with club publicity. The Garioch WPO will approve all such photographs. Please contact the Meet Convener should you not wish for your swimmer's photograph to be taken. **Mobile phones must not be used in the changing village, showers or toilets and must be switched to silent in the pool hall.**

Transgender & Non-Binary Competition Policy

As of the 1st January 2024 the Scottish Swimming Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy was implemented nationally across all aquatics sports. The policy and FAQs can be found at https://www.scottishswimming.com/about-us/equality.

Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event.

As a result of this policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.

Meet Regulations

No guarantee can be given by GASC that the event will take place at a particular time or any particular date and GASC reserves the right to reschedule or cancel the event without notice and liability for doing so. It is expected that this would only happen as a result of unforeseen circumstances e.g. COVID-19 outbreak, venue/facility failure or adverse weather. Garioch ASC will have no legal liability to make any refund or to pay any form of consequential or indirect damage such as loss of enjoyment, travel and accommodation costs should the meet be required to be cancelled or changed.

This event is run in accordance with Scottish Swimming Competition Management Guidance and codes of conduct prevailing at the time of the event; requirements for the meet may need to be changed in accordance with any change in regulations/legislation. A risk assessment has been carried out and takes into consideration the information contained within this document.

Data Protection

In order to operate this meet, we have a legitimate interest to collect and process some basic personal data from all competitors, specifically name, gender, date of birth. This data will be held securely and only used for the purposes of managing the meet and reporting results. Dates of birth will only be shared with:

- Scottish Swimming for the purpose of maintaining the National Database which is used for Squad Selection and
- Swim England for inclusion on Rankings

Names, gender and age (but not date of birth) will be retained and will be shared with attending clubs and may be published for the purpose of reporting and keeping records.

Notes	All swimmers, poolside helpers and coaches taking part should have a current SASA membership. Registration numbers must be shown on entry files. A license has been applied for and accreditation will be applied for with SASA.
	Poolside access will be limited to one Coach per 10 swimmers, with a maximum of 3 Coaches at any one time.
	Meal tickets for lunch are available for coaches at £8 per person per day – please include within the summary sheet provided.
	Belongings should be placed in the lockers provided within the changing village. No large bags are allowed on poolside due to minimal space. Each competitor should bring (as a minimum):
	Sufficient water in a plastic water bottle(s) – water can be refilled at the water fountain if required; Shorts & t-shirt to wear over the swimsuit/swim shorts at all times when not swimming; Poolside shoes (e.g. crocs/clean trainers/flip flops) – these should be changed into prior to entering the changing village.

	Seating areas will be allocated to each team. Teams are responsible for clearing their seating area of belongings, litter etc. before leaving at the end of the competition day.
