Start Rule	One start will be implemented throughout the competition. Over the top starts will be used where practicable.
Entries	All swimmers entered must be registered with SASA and have paid their SASA membership fee for the current year. Registration numbers must be included in entry file. Times do not require to be accredited but should be real times achieved at accredited or non-accredited meets or club time trials. An entry time must be submitted for each entry. Orkney ASC reserves the right to restrict the number of heats in any event/s, reserves the right to swim a slower heat for their swimmers and reserves the right to fill any empty lanes with Orkney ASC swimmers.
