Consideration Times	Thurso ASC reserves the right to restrict the number of heats in any event(s), reserves the right to swim a slower heat for their swimmers and to fill any empty lanes with Thurso ASC swimmers. Heats will be swum slowest to fastest. Qualifying times for the the 50 Open Male & Open = to or faster than 31.00 Qualifying times for the Female – 50m Open Sprint = to or faster than 33.00 Entries to the events will be restricted and will be accepted based on entry times. Any entry not accepted will be refunded. Entries will not be accepted from composite teams.

Withdrawals at the Event	Withdrawals from heats at the competition should be notified on the withdrawal form issued. The withdrawal form should be submitted to the Recorders' table at least 45 minutes prior to the start of the appropriate session.

By entering the Female category, swimmers are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.
Data Protection	In order to operate this meet, we have a legitimate interest to collect and process some basic personal data from all competitors, specifically name, eligibility category and date of birth. This data will be held securely and only used for the purposes of managing the meet and reporting results. Dates of Birth (DOB) will only be shared with: • Scottish Swimming for the purpose of maintaining the National Database which is used for Squad Selection and • Swim England for inclusion on Rankings. • TASC/Clubs – names, eligibility, category and age (not DOB) will be retained and will be shared with attending clubs and may be published for the purpose of reporting and keeping records.
