	In the event of postponement, cancellation or abandonment of the event or withdrawals at any time, refunds will be made at the absolute discretion of Cults Otters ASC.
	Please note that this gala is intended for novice swimmers only (ie those not competing at North District Level). With the exception of Cults Otters, team entries will be accepted on a first come, first accepted basis. All Cults swimmers will be accepted.
	Because this competition is intended to be a friendly, welcoming opportunity for learning for young swimmers, the full World Aquatics rules of swimming will not be applied. The meet will be run under the following conditions:  Forward facing starts with a dive from the blocks, or from in the water will all be permitted.  Swimmers will only be disqualified for the following:
Special Conditions	<ul> <li>Starting before the signal (although a restart will usually be offered) or doing a "flyer" in a relay</li> <li>Swimming the wrong stroke in either an individual event or a relay</li> <li>Not completing the full distance (including not touching the end at a turn)</li> <li>Actions that are against the rules AND gain a clear unfair advantage eg pulling on the lane rope or swimming underwater</li> </ul>
	Although a Novice Gala, Coaches should ensure that swimmers are capable of completing the stroke / distance according to World Aquatics technical requirements before entering swimmers into an event.
	We would like to encourage clubs to enter relay teams to promote team spirit and fun at this novice event.
Entries	Entries to be made using the Hytek Team Manager events file. Events files may be obtained by download from the North District website ( <a href="www.sasanorth.org.uk">www.sasanorth.org.uk</a> ) or by email from <a href="cultsotters.galaorg@gmail.com">cultsotters.galaorg@gmail.com</a> . All entry files must be returned by email and the fees and other paperwork to be sent on as soon as possible after this. Receipt of entry file will be confirmed by email.
	We would be grateful for the offer of technical officials. Technical Officials	Any queries or changes to Technical Officials after the closing date should also be directed to the STO Co-Ordinator. All clubs are requested to provide a minimum of 1 STO per session (ideally Judge level if possible). Clubs that have 10 swimmers or more accepted should provide a minimum of 2 technical officials per session, at least one of which should hold a minimum qualification of Judge 1.
	Mentoring requests will be at the discretion of the Referee. It may be more likely for mentoring requests be honoured if there are adequate qualified officials to cover the roles, however we cannot guarantee all requests will be granted.



	Please note that Timekeepers or Judges-in-training requiring specific signatures, i.e. Chief timekeeper or stroke judge, should make this request when STO names are submitted.
Transgender and Non-Binary Policy	As of the 1st January 2024 the Scottish Swimming Transgender & Non-Binary Competition Policy was implemented nationally across all aquatics sports. The policy and FAQs can be found at <a href="https://www.scottishswimming.com/about-us/equality">https://www.scottishswimming.com/about-us/equality</a> . Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event. As a result of this policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to compete in the Female category.
Withdrawals	Must be notified to <a href="mailto:cultsotters.galaorg@gmail.com">cultsotters.galaorg@gmail.com</a> by email before <b>5pm Friday 20th February 2026</b> and after this to the Recorders table on the day – withdrawals should be notified at least 1 hour prior to the start of the appropriate session.
Photography	No photographic or video equipment will be allowed in any area without prior agreement of the Gala Organiser. Application forms will be available from the Gala Organiser and must be countersigned by a club official. Photographic permission will not be issued for mobile phones.  Unless it has been notified in writing to the Gala Organiser it will be assumed that all parents of children swimming give permission for their child to be photographed by approved parties.  Photography of any description, and the use of mobile phones or any other devices capable of photography is strictly prohibited in the changing room, showers, and toilets. The use of mobile phones poolside is prohibited.
Changing Room	The changing room at the pool will be available for use but time in this area should be limited as far as possible. Bags can be taken into the seating area where space in that area allows. No belongings can be left in the changing rooms.
Marshalling	Swimmers must report to marshalling ahead of their event otherwise they will not be permitted to swim. The start of a race will not be delayed for absent competitors. Swimmers must follow instructions given to them by meet officials and marshals, and must behave in a reasonable manner at all times.
Spectating	All available space (as defined by building regulations) will be prioritised for swimmers, team staff and STO's. Any available capacity may be allocated to spectating subject to compliance with building regulations. Details will be confirmed once all entries have been processed.



Data Protection	In order to operate the Cults Otters Novice Gala, we have a legitimate interest to collect and process some basic personal data from all competitors, specifically name, gender, date of birth.  This data will be held securely and only used for the purposes of managing the meet and reporting results. The data will be retained in accordance with Licence Requirements. Names and ages will be shared with attending clubs and SASA ND and may be published. Name, gender and date of birth will only be used when submitting the results to Scottish Rankings for the purpose of maintaining the National Database.  By entering the Cults Otters Novice Gala competitors agree to allow Cults Otters ASC to publish the personal data submitted within the entry file and allow publication of results.
