a)	Club Timekeeper Course	The District will pay directly to Scottish Swimming, the fee for all Timekeeper courses that have at least 8 Timekeepers on the course. Clubs that do not have 8 Timekeepers of their own on the course should work with other clubs to fill the spaces. Clubs that run courses that take place with fewer than 8 Timekeepers in total, must refund the District for the course.

Assistance to purchase Headsets/Radios	<p>£150.00 or 75% if cost is less</p> <p>North District Clubs who run at least one open meet per year shall be subsidised in the purchase of headsets/radios up to the sum of £150 per club or 75% whichever is less up to a maximum of 8 headsets/radios.</p> <p>Radios/headsets will become club property and any subsequent maintenance or replacement will be the club's responsibility.</p> <p>Clubs can apply for this subsidy no more frequently than once every five (5) years.</p> <p>Enquiries should be made to the District Treasurer, with applications for a subsidy to be submitted on an Expenses Form. Receipts must be submitted to the District Treasurer prior to payment.</p>
6.	Education support for Coaches and Technical Officials.	<p>Applications will be considered by the SASA North District Executive and the Convenor for the relevant discipline and the decision reached will be final for all subsidies.</p> <p>Please apply using his form: https://forms.office.com/r/tfQwXc46Ub</p>
a)	Subsidy for Club Staff taking SSTQ, SSCQ or Equivalent Qualification (from a strictly limited budget and subject to review before 2025 AGM)	<p>Clubs can apply for a subsidy to support them to train their staff with an SSTQ, an SSCQ, or an equivalent Diving, Artistic, Water Polo or Open Water equivalent when available.</p> <p>The rate shall be <u>up to</u> £200 per course completed and subsidies are limited to:</p> <p>One (1) per club per 100 athletes (or part of 100 athletes) per year with athletes counted on 1 December.</p> <p>This subsidy <u>may</u> be considered in addition to any available for clubs with club staff meeting costs associated with remote locations.</p>
b)	Remote location subsidy (from a strictly limited budget)	<p>Clubs can apply for a subsidy to support remote areas and regions in accessing education and development opportunities.</p> <p>Applications can be made by clubs, where it can be demonstrated that there are significant barriers and the barriers that are present could be removed or reduced by financial support from the SASA North District that is not available elsewhere.</p>
